On-campus Accommodation

The dormitories for Tsinghua University’s international students are Zijing Apartment Block 19–23. There are 3 types of rooms available, namely Double, AB and Single Room, with Double Room being the cheapest at 40 yuan/day, while AB and Single Room are equally priced at 80 yuan/day.

All rooms are equipped with a study desk, bed and wardrobe. All buildings also come with common study areas for students to use. Additionally, kitchens are also available on certain floors in blocks 21-23, but you will have to purchase your own kitchen equipment.

In accordance with the University’s laws, only international students from Tsinghua University are allowed to reside in Zijing Apartment Block 19-23. Friends and relatives are allowed to visit, but they will be required to produce identifications

and register at the front desk, and must leave the premises by 11pm. Overnight stay is prohibited in these dormitories. Students living in these dormitories must abide by all dormitory rules, including but not limited to the following: Smoking, using candles, heating blankets and rice cookers are prohibited.

Regarding all issues relating to the dormitories, please enquire at the front desk on the ground level of your block or at level 1 of Zijing block 19. If you have already reserved a room, please approach the service staff at block 19 with your passport, admission notice and sufficient cash to register. The front desk at block 19 also accepts credit/debit card payments.

Off-campus Accommodation

As campus dormitories have limited availability, the University is unable to provide accommodation for all international students. Students who failed to obtain room reservations can rent an apartment together outside campus.

Recommended housing apartments around campus (for reference only):

“Hua Qing Jia Yuan” & “Dong Sheng Yuan”

Many international students live in these two housing areas as they are around Wudaokou and very near school.



Tips:

- 01 There are many housing agents out there, please exercise caution and compare prices across different agents/rental platforms before making your decision.
- 02 Exercise extra caution when signing the rental contract and be aware for hidden clauses. Always err on the side of caution and clarify anything that you are unsure of, especially the expiry date and compensation clauses.
- 03 Remind your housing agent to apply for a *Registration Form of Temporary Residence* for you at the local police station. (Very important!)

- 04 Prices for apartments will be more expensive in these areas mentioned above as they are in Wudaokou, a more bustling district. Actual prices also depend on the size of the rooms. It is recommended to share a room with other friends to share the cost of the apartment.
- 05 Lowest rental prices if sharing a room (excluding internet and utility fees):
 - With balcony 2800 yuan/month
 - Without balcony 2500 yuan/month

You will need to activate and top up your internet account for your first use since charges will be deducted directly from your account (see Activating Internet Account below). You can top up your internet account by visiting the Network Center Office（网络中心办公室）(operating hours: 13:00 – 16:00).

There are two other more convenient ways to top up your internet account. First is via the webpage <http://usereg.tsinghua.edu.cn/>. You can also change the password of your school's email account, view

transaction history, etc. The second way is via the self-service kiosks located at various dining halls, such as Zhi Lan Yuan, Tao Li Yuan, Zi Jing Yuan and Guan Chou Yuan, Teaching Building 6 and Students' Service Centre (C Building).

For any issue regarding the school network, you can contact the Network Center at 62784859 or 51774859 (daily from 08:00 – 22:00, excluding holidays), or email them at support@tsinghua.edu.cn.

Note: IPv6 service is free-of-charge. For more information, please check out ipv6.tsinghua.edu.cn.

Activating Internet Account

You can activate your network account by going to the Network Center Office（网络中心办公室）with your student card or Admission Notice to apply for an Internet account. Please be reminded to top up your account to activate it.

Accessing the Internet

Once your account is activated, Internet service is easily accessible in your dormitory and around campus via LAN ports and wireless networks (network name is Tsinghua). Do note that there are 1-2 LAN port(s) in your dormitory.

Once connected via LAN port or wireless, just launch your web browser and type in <http://net.tsinghua.edu.cn>, and key in your ID and password. Do remember to log out when you wish to go offline since others might access your account if you do not do so. To manage your account (such as to disconnect a particular connection or to check your current balance), please sign in via <http://usereg.tsinghua.edu.cn>.

To help users to manage their data usage, the school has also come up with a software, TUNET, which caters to both computers and mobile devices. The software can be downloaded at <http://net.tsinghua.edu.cn>.

If you have a computer or mobile device that can connect to the wireless network, you will be able to access the Internet by following the steps mentioned in the previous section. If not, there are a few locations around campus for you to access the Internet using school computers. These school computer labs are located at:

- At the back (North) of the Main Building（主楼）；
- On the fourth floor of the Teaching Building 4（四教）；
- Libraries.

Note: Although the Tsinghua wireless network can be accessed in the dormitory, the signal is usually weak

and the connection speed may be slow. Thus, you are recommended to install a router in your room.

Potable Water

Tap water is not potable in China, hence the need for a water dispenser. Water tickets (水票) which can be exchanged for barrels of water (each barrel containing 18.9 litres of water and can last for approximately a week or two) can be purchased from multiple vendors at around 10-12 RMB a barrel. One such vendor can be reached via 62773725. Usually, 30 water tickets purchased comes with a free water dispenser, and if you do not want the water dispenser, the company will give you a few more water tickets for free. The more barrels of water you buy, the more free tickets you get. You can try to bargain for a better deal. A deposit of 50 RMB is required for a barrel.

Alternatively, you may purchase bottles of water from the supermarkets.

Registration, Activation, Topping up and Replacement of Dining Card

When eating in canteens, you will need to use your Student IC as a dining card to pay for the food purchased. You can also use this Student IC to pay at supermarkets on campus. To activate or top-up your student IC, you need to top up at the self-service kiosks, which can be found at places including Zhi Lan Yuan, Tao Li Yuan, Zi Jing Yuan, Guan Chou Yuan, Teaching Building 6, or the Students’ Service Center (C Building). For replacement of the Student IC, please proceed to the Registration Center located at Room 301, Section 3 of Teaching Building 3 to get it replaced at a fee.

Off-campus Eateries

To the south (outside East Gate or South Gate) of the campus, there are many food outlets, including McDonalds, KFC, Pizza Hut, Subway, Yoshinoya (a Japanese restaurant), and varies bars, especially in the Wudaokou area.

To know whether the food in a particular restaurant is good, you can check out <http://www.dianping.com/>, where you will find reviews posted by others. It is generally reliable but the downside is that it is only available in Chinese.

Calling with Dormitory Landline

All International student dormitories come with a landline for incoming and outgoing calls.

For outgoing calls

1.To other international student dormitories

Simply dial the room’s phone number (5 digit) of your friend’s dormitory. To determine a room’s phone number, check the digital display of the room’s phone; the room’s full phone number will be displayed there. Use the last five digits for room-to-room calls. The service is free.

2.To external lines

To dial out, you will need to choose one of the two following options:

a. Use a Railcom telephone card (铁通电话卡): Please follow the instructions on the back of the card (Chinese). You can buy telephone cards from either General Service Desk on the 1st floor of Zi Jing No.19 student dormitory or Room 103 in the Student Service Center.

b. Use a 201-telephone card: First dial 2012 and then follow the instructions from the phone.

For incoming calls

The code for China and Beijing is 86-10-xxxxxxx (your number, found on the display of your landline).

You can purchase a Telephone Card at the Front Desk of Zijing Block 19 or Room 103 at the Students’ Service Center (C Building).

Calling with Mobile Phones

Most of China’s telecommunication providers offer pre-paid cell phone service. To get started, simply purchase a SIM card and you can get buy top-up cards to recharge your account whenever the value in your account is running low. During the start of the semester, telecommunication providers will usually hold fairs in school and there will be many freebies given if you top up a substantial amount (usually at least 50 Yuan). The promotions are quite good so it is recommended that you hold off any large value top-ups until the fair. To top up, you can purchase top-up cards which are available at most of the bookstands around campus, visit the company’s website or taobao, or at the business hall of the phone company. Alternatively, you can top up through WeChat’s Wallet, Alipay or through the official app of the telecom company.

If you need to purchase a mobile phone, a large variety of choices are available at Wudaokou mobile phone market. Do take extra precaution when purchasing mobile phones and make sure that you purchase from a licensed shop.

Types of Phone Cards

China Mobile (中国移动)

M-Zone (动感地带) : A phone card most Tsinghua students use, specifically customized for the youth. It has a variety of packages and personalized services. Its SMS charge is the lowest.

Gotone (全球通) : Has the highest quality services, but the monthly charges and fees are also really high. It is suitable for people who have a high demand for voice quality.

Easyown (神州行) : Has no monthly charges and it is used by most of the Chinese people. It is relatively simple, affordable and popular, suitable for those who seldom call and send text messages. (Has an expiry date, but extendable by topping up account.)

China Union (联通)

U-power (UP 新势力) : Has monthly rent. Functional similarity with the M-Zone. It is cheaper, but it may have no signal in some regions.

CDMA Card (CDMA 卡) : Has monthly rent, has high quality voice calls.

RuYiTong (如意通) : Has no monthly charges but fees are relatively high. Suitable for people who seldom call. (Has an expiry date, but extendable by topping up account.)

China Telecom (中国电信)

China Telecom’s phone card can only be used in its mobile phones.

Making International Calls

To make international calls, there are two options. You can purchase an international calling card, also known as IP card, from shops such as the bookstands. Alternatively, you can activate the international call service of your mobile phone card provider. Some types of the cards do not have this service activated by default, so you need to call

10086 (China Mobile) or 10010 (China Union) to subscribe to it.

After subscribing, you can either:

- 01** Directly dial:"00 + country or region code + city code + destination number "or" 00 + country or region code + mobile phone number. "
- 02** IP dial: For example, if you use China Mobile Card, dial the IP number "12593"or "17951" in front of other numbers. The format is "17951 +00 + country or area code + city code + destination number "or" 17951 +00 + country or area code + mobile phone number. "

In addition, each kind of mobile phone card has a corresponding international long-distance call preferential business, which greatly reduces the fees of international calls.

Alternatively, you can also use VoIP services, such as Skype and Wechat to make international calls.

Post Office

Fee

Airmail letters weighing 20 grams or less cost 6 yuan in postage. Exceeding that, the cost will increase with the weight of the letter.

DHL Express delivery

DHL Pick-up Point: east of Zijing Student's Apartment Block 11

Delivery Pick-up Point

Tsinghua has a designated delivery pick-up point, located at Zijing Student Apartment Block 14 (northern side of the campus). Most parcels will be delivered to this place. You can pick up parcels that are delivered to you or drop off parcels to mail to

others. Among all the service providers, Shunfeng and EMS provide better and faster deliveries, but costs slightly more than ordinary companies like Zhongtong, Yunda, Shentong, Tiantian, etc.

You are recommended to ask the post office clerk to weigh the letter or parcel and to get the correct postage charge before mailing a letter or parcel. Also, do note the difference between snail mail and registered mail when sending out your letters/parcels.

Common Banking Services

Most students will be able to register for a bank account with Bank of China, which can be linked to your Student ICs. This card will be used for administrative matters that require deposition or deduction of cash by the school, as well as receiving reimbursement/allowance from the school.

If you wish to do online shopping, remember to activate internet banking service at the local bank to access your bank account online.

If you are looking to traveling to other countries, you will have to go to the banks to exchange CNY for foreign currency. Please note that you may have to inform the banks in advance of your intention to obtain foreign currency, by either calling its hotline or in-person, since they might not have it on hand. Also, there is a cap of USD 500 worth of foreign currency that can be exchanged by a foreigner per day per passport, so do plan ahead if you need a large amount of foreign currency on short notice.

When exchanging money for other currencies:

- 01 Bring along your passport.
- 02 Different banks offer slightly different exchange rates.
- 03 Currency exchange between CNY and foreign currencies is controlled in China. Remember to keep the exchange receipts when you change your money to CNY so you can show it to the bank staff to obtain the same rate when you want to convert it back to the original currency.

Main Banks around the Campus

Bank of China (Office Hours: 09:00 – 17:00)

The Bank of China has the most number of ATM machine on campus, and hence it might be the most convenient bank for students. The nearest branch is located at Zi Jing Student Service Center (C Building) but the queue can get very long. Alternatively, you can visit the branch that is located in the Chuang Xin Building (创新大厦) at Tsinghua Tech Park which is just outside the Eastern Gate or branch outside the Western gate.

Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (ICBC) located in the central areas of Zhao Lan Yuan (照澜院) .

China Construction Bank located in the central areas of Zhao Lan Yuan and outside East Gate.

Bank of Beijing located in the central areas of Zhao Lan Yuan.

Taxis

Taxis are a common sight in Beijing, and are relatively cheaper than most countries. In addition, there are also many private cars operating as illegal taxis (known as 黑车). These illegal taxis usually charge more than the legal ones and might not be as safe.

***Note:** Illegal taxis can also operate in the form of “regular taxis”.

Taxi Fare

There is only one kind of taxis, costing 2.30 yuan/km, and the starting fare is 13 yuan for the first 3 km.

Identifying Legal Taxis

Check the number on the license plate. Legal ones always start with “京B” before the number. Please keep the invoice given by the taxi driver.

Alternatively, you can download an app called “滴滴出行” (didi chuxing), similar to Uber, and hail private taxis using the app. The prices quoted by these apps are usually slightly lower than traditional taxis.

Subway and Light Rail Trains

The fare varies according to the distance of your destination, with the actual fare calculation as follows: first 6 km is 3 yuan; 6-12 km is 4 yuan; 12-22 km is 5 yuan; 22-32 km is 6 yuan; above 32 km, 1 yuan for every 20 km with no upper fare limit.

Please refer to <http://www.bjsubway.com> to get the map of the subway and the light rail train.

Note: There is announcement of the upcoming station in English while you are on board a train. Also, there are train maps available in every station.

Public Buses

Buses are a cheap form of transport with cash fare starting from 2 yuan. If you use the Beijing City Transportation Yi Ka Tong (一卡通), then the basic fare begins from 1yuan. Please be aware that most bus conductors do not speak English. It is difficult to take a bus if you cannot speak or understand Chinese. There are bus stations outside North-East Gate (东北门), West Gate (西门) and South Gate (南门). The bus station at North-East Gate is nearest to the International students’ dormitories and you can take bus 549 to places such as Wu Dao Kou and Zhong Guan Cun.

Campus Shuttles

The shuttle has a fixed 20 minutes route around the campus. The first bus is at 7:30 am and the last bus is at 7:30 pm. You can get on it wherever you catch it, and you can do so by just waving to the bus driver. Bus fare: 1 yuan (2 yuan without student ID card). Recently, a new initiative has been launched which allow users to track the location of the bus using the school’s official app.



Bicycles (Bike-sharing)

Riding a bicycle is the way of life in China, and Tsinghua is no exception. Most local students commute in bicycles to their destinations, and the morning bicycle jam on the roads to the classrooms has always been a sight to behold.

If you are looking to purchase one, a new one will set you back around 200 to 500 yuan, depending on the specifications that you are looking for. As a rule of thumb, a new, decent, fixed gear bike will cost 250 yuan or less. A second hand bike should cost 150 yuan or less at most bicycle shops and you are encouraged to survey around and bargain down the quoted price. It is often cheaper to buy a used bicycle from a student, rather than from a bicycle shop.

If you are buying from a shop, the shops in Zhao Lan Yuan (照澜院) and the shops outside the West Gate (西门) are places that offer bicycles that are of good value. Do also remember to get a reliable lock since theft cases are commonplace, even in the school campus. Most importantly, park your bike in safe places, most preferably in well-lit areas where service staff can keep an eye on it.

If your bicycle requires any maintenance, there are many bicycle shops around the campus that will be able to provide the service, though it will be wise to ask around for the shops that provide better services.

Bike sharing

Bike sharing refers to bicycles provided for rental by various companies for a nominal fee. These bicycles can usually be found on campus, around subway stations, bus stops, neighbourhoods, business districts and other public areas.

Supermarkets on Campus

Tsinghua is like a mini town, with many ancillary services present on campus to service the population there. Hence, there are a wide variety of goods and services that you can obtain on campus.

There are four supermarkets on campus, which provide a convenient way for students to purchase their daily essentials.

For the Guan Chou Yuan and Zi Jing supermarkets listed above, they hold similar items, such as drinks, snacks and fruits. The Zi Jing supermarket also sells freshly made food, clothing and bags, though they are somewhat pricey. If you are interested in cooking, you should check out the Zhao Lan Yuan supermarket, since it sells both fresh (some of them) and frozen food but it is relatively further away from the dormitory. The prices of the items in these three supermarkets are comparable. Apart from paying in cash at these supermarkets, you also have the option of paying using your student IC card.

Market for Fresh Fruits, Vegetables and Meat

If you are a keen cook and are interested to buy the freshest ingredients, then you must check out the market located in Zhao Lan Yuan, which is opposite to the Zhao Lan Yuan supermarket mentioned above.

This market has a wide variety of fresh fruits, vegetables and meat (including seafood). The prices of the fruits are cheaper than those found in the supermarkets mentioned above and seem to be in better condition. If you are on good terms with the sellers, they will even throw in an item or two for free!

Note: The commonly used Chinese measurement for weight is Jin (斤). One Jin equals to 0.5 kilogram, and a little more than one pound (1 Jin equals to 1.1 Pound).

Other Goods and Services Available on Campus

Drugstore/Pharmacy

A drugstore is located in Zhao Lan Yuan (quite near to the supermarket), and it sells a variety of Chinese and Western medicine.

Photography Services

For printing of photographs and other photography-related services, there are two shops available in Tsinghua. One of them is located at the Student’s Service Center, while the other is located at Zhao Lan Yuan. The former is more conveniently located but may be more expensive.

Optical Services

There are several optics shops on campus, one of which is located at the Students’ Service Center, while another is located at the ground floor of the storehouse where Dufeng Bookstore is also located (near Guan Chou Yuan).

Repair of Electronic Gadgets

The bookstand at the basement 1 of the Students’ Service Center provides servicing for electronic gadgets.

Repair/Replacement of Watch Batteries

There is a watch mechanic located at the west of the Zhao Lan Yuan Market.

If you wish to study in a particular classroom, do check out the timetable that is on its door to know when it is available. Most classrooms are closed at 10 pm so if you wish to continue studying, cafes or the halls found in the International students' dormitories are good options.

Do also note that there can be other possible classrooms in which you may have lessons or can go for self-study, such as: New/Old department building of Hydraulic Engineering and your faculty's

building. You can find out more from your seniors if you are interested to know more.

Tip: For the registration for a new semester (excluding freshmen matriculation) and the printing of enrolment certificate or academic transcripts, you need to go to the Office of Academic Affairs (Registration Center) at Section 3 of Teaching Building 3.If you are a full-time student, depending on the academic-related issue that you are facing, you may need to visit either the Office of Academic

Affairs （教 务 处）of Tsinghua University or the Office of Academic Affairs of your faculty.

Libraries

There are many libraries located around the campus. The Yi Fu Hall, Main Library （图 书 馆 新 馆（逸 夫 馆））, the Humanities and Social Sciences Library （人 文 图 书 馆）, old library and Mochtar Riady library are generic libraries where students from all faculties can enter. The specialized libraries, which include Economics and Management Library, Law Library, Architecture Library and Arts Library limit access to the students that they admit (no restrictions if you belong to that specialization) so do find out more if you wish to visit them. Different types of books are kept in the various libraries so if you wish to find a particular kind of book, you can use the library website, <http://lib.tsinghua.edu.cn>, to find out if it is on the shelf.

All students can borrow up to 20 books at one go. You can also renew your loans on the library website.

In addition, libraries are popular among students for self-studying so do note that seats will be hard to find during the examination period.

Note: The overview of the libraries given here is rather brief, so do find out more information from the friendly librarians in order to make good use of library resources.

Study Materials

For textbooks and reference materials, there are several bookstores in school that sell both brand new and second-hand items:

01 Shuimu Bookstore （水 木 书 店）, located in the basement of Students' Service Center (C building). It sells both brand new and second-hand books.

02 The basement of Guan Chou Yuan dining hall, sells books and manga.

03 Dufeng Bookstore （独 峰 书 院）, which is located near the Guan Chou Yuan dining hall. It has a large collection of first-hand and second-hand books.

04 We can also go on amazon.com and order any books you like and let the postman deliver the book to Materials Center for you to pick it up.

05 Basement of Qing Fen Dining Hall.

06 Beside Qing Feng Zhan Ying supermarket （清 风 湛 影 超 市）.

For stationaries

01 Zi Jing Supermarket （紫 荆 超 市）, which is located at the basement of the of Students' Service Center (C building). The stationeries there are slightly expensive.

02 Stationery Store, located at 清西文化长廊 , just below Dufeng Bookstore. The stationeries are cheaper than the supermarket, and the shop also sells electronic and sports equipment. Incidentally, there is an Apple Store located next to it.

Lastly, there are many printing shops around the campus so it is really convenient for you to print out your notes. Do note that the price of printing is 0.10 yuan per page and you should avoid shops that charge you more. C Building is an exception as they use slightly thicker paper, so they charge 0.20 yuan per page.

There are a total of 2011 seats in the main seating area of this auditorium, including stalls and three levels of seats. It is also equipped with two side stages and an orchestra pit with elevation, as well as professional-grade lighting and sound systems to cater to large-scale concerts at the highest levels of professional standards and cultural campus activities to promote academic interactions.

Apart from the sound-proofing capabilities of this auditorium, it also houses dressing rooms, multi-purpose halls, practice rooms, VIP rooms and other facilities.

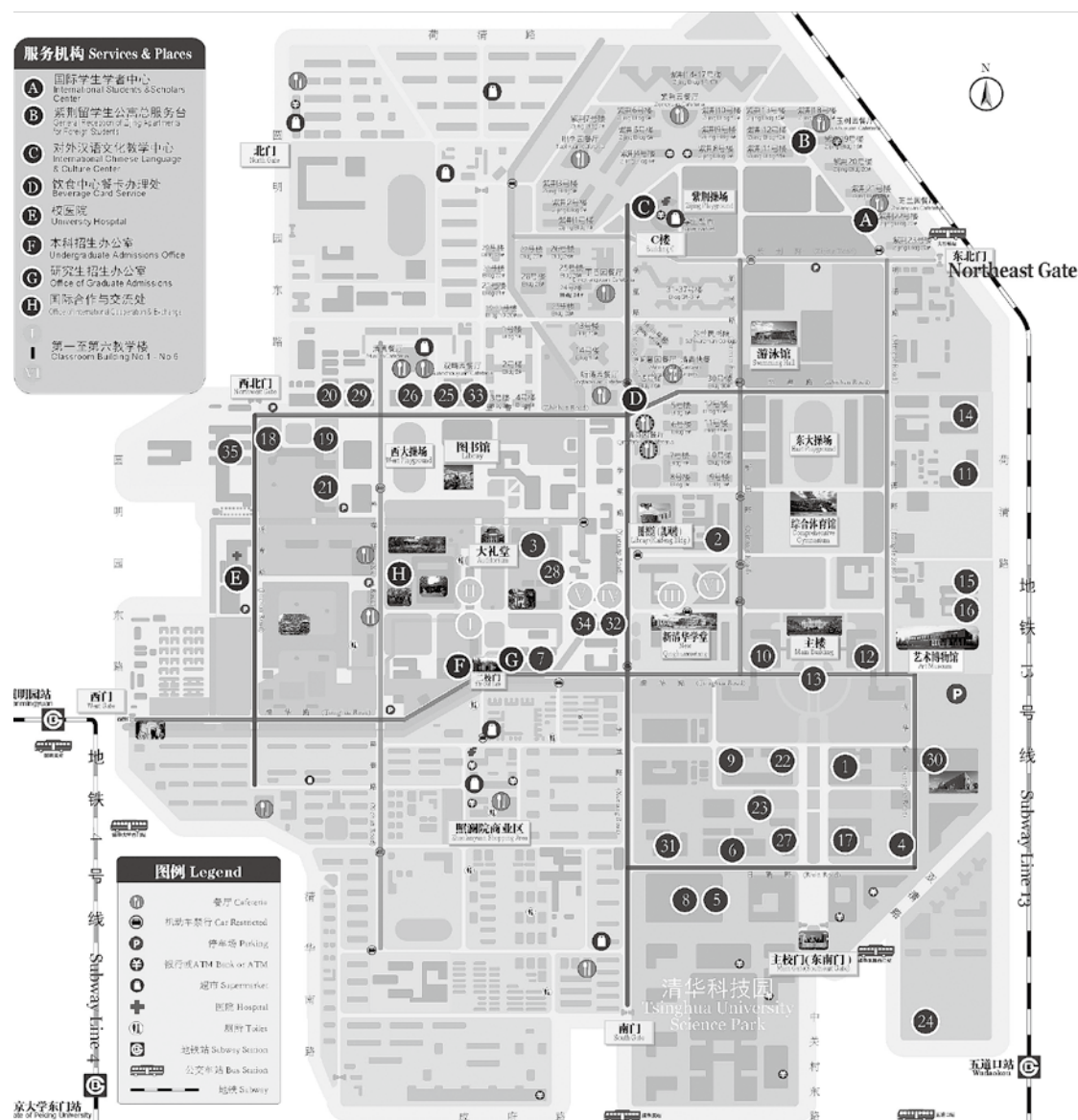

手机拨打电话

大多数的中国电信公司提供预付费的电信服务。若要开始使用电信服务，你只需购买一张手机卡，并在账户余额不足时购买充值卡。在学期开始的时候，电信公司通常会在校内设立展台来宣传。此时是个充值账户的良好时机，因为商家会依照你的充值的金额赠送多种礼物，例如自行车、交通卡、U 盘等（通常充值要求至少 50 元）。因此，建议在此之前不要充太多的话费，在活动期间充值才是上策。若你想在非活动期间充值，可以到校内的报刊亭、该厂商的网站、淘宝或电信公司的营业厅购买充值卡或直接充值。除此之外，你也能通过微信钱包、支付宝钱包或该电信公司的官方手机应用（app）进行充值。

如果你需要购买手机，五道口手机市场有大量的款式供你选择。购买时，请务必小心，确保买的东西是你所购买的。

中国移动

- 01 动感地带：清华学生使用最广泛的一种手机卡。专为年轻人定制，有多种套餐和个性化服务，中国国内短信费可观。
- 02 全球通：服务质量最高，但月租和收费高。适合对话音质量有很高需求的人。

拨打国际长途电话

拨打国际长途电话的方法有两种。

方法一：从报刊亭购买国际长途电话卡，俗称 IP 卡；

方法二：开通国际长途业务，有的卡默认是没有开通国际长途的，需要致电 10086（中国移动）或 10010（联通公司）申请开通。

在开通之后，有两种拨打方式

- 01 直接拨打方式：“00 + 国家或地区代码 + 城市代码 + 对方号码”或“00 + 国家或地区代码 + 对方手机号码”。
- 02 IP 拨号拨打方式：如移动的使用 12593 或 17951 这样的 IP 接入号，拨号格式是：“17951 + 00 + 国家或地区代码 + 城市代码 + 对方号码”或“17951 + 00 + 国家或地区代码 + 对方手机号码”。

另外，每一种类型的手机卡都有相应的国际长途优惠业务，使国际话费大大降低。如果你经常打电话回家，建议开通相应套餐。

大部分的同学在报到时都可以办理一张中国银行卡，这张卡会与学生卡绑定。办理学校相关的金钱存储与支付手续都会通过这个账户进行。

如果你想进行网上购物，请记得到银行分行开通网银服务，这样你才能进行在线支付。

如果你想到别的国家旅游，那你需要兑换外币。在中国，只有银行提供兑换外币的服务。请在你想换外币之前先到银行分行的柜台确认是否有该外币的存货，有时候有可能会需要你提前预约。另外，非中国公民都有“一个护照一天只能换取不超过 500 美金”的限制，因此如果你需要大量的外币，请提前计划。

小贴士：

- 01 进行货币兑换前，请出示你的护照。
- 02 不同银行的兑换率会有所不同。
- 03 目前，中国还不允许人民币和外币的自由兑换。因此，请妥善保管你兑换人民币时的收据，在你回国前进行外币兑换时，需要向银行职员出示该收据。

出租车

出租车在中国比比皆是，价格与其他国家相比相对便宜。需要注意的是北京也有很多黑车。这些黑车一般价格会比合法的出租车贵，而且不一定安全。

北京的出租车价格是 2.30 元每公里，起步价是前三公里 13 元。

确认合法的出租车牌照

打车时请确认牌照上的号码，合法的出租车号码将以“京 B”作为开头。请保存出租车票收据。

另外，你也能在手机上下载“滴滴出行”app 来呼叫私家车。这些 app 给出的价格通常会比普通出租车便宜许多。

地铁和城铁（轨道交通）

本市轨道交通（除机场线外）实行计程限时票制，具体票价方案为起步 6 公里(含)内 3 元, 6 公里至 12 公里(含) 4 元, 12 公里至 22 公里(含) 5 元, 22 公里至 32 公里(含) 6 元, 32 公里以上部分，每增加 1 元可乘坐 20 公里。票价不封顶。乘客乘坐轨道交通一次行程在付费区内最多可停留 4 小时。详情请登录 <http://www.bjsubway.com> 查询。

市内公交车

公交车是非常便宜的交通工具。支付现金的起步价是 2 元，北京市交通一卡通的起步价是 1 元钱。清华大学的西门、南门、东北门附近均有公交车站。东北门的巴士站最靠近国际学生宿舍，你可以乘搭 549 到五道口与中关村。

校园公交车

校园公交车按指定路线绕清华校园，首班车发车时间是：早上 7:30，末班车发车时间是：晚上 19:30，每班车间隔时间为 20 分钟。票价：学生票（出示学生证）1 元，其它 2 元。

自行车（共享单车）

骑自行车在中国是一种很常见的交通方式。很多中国同学都会骑自行车到他们的目的地。

一辆新的自行车价格为 200-500 元，具体价格取决于自行车类型。一辆崭新的，不能换挡的自行车的价位大约是 250 元或以下，一辆二手自行车则是大约在 150 元或以下。建议你尽量多问问几家店，做比较，并尽可能地讲价。一般来说，向同学购买二手自行车的价格会比店铺的便宜。

照澜院与西门外的自行车店都是买车比较好的地方，车的价格比较公道。由于校内丢车现象比较严重，最好买一个比较结实的锁，并且将车停放在安全的地方。

校内修车地点也有很多，但所提供的服务品质参差不齐，建议向学长们咨询。

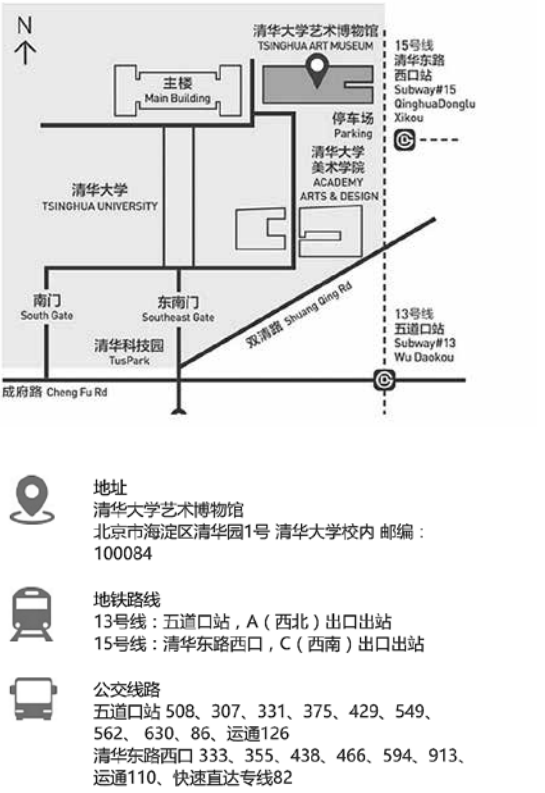

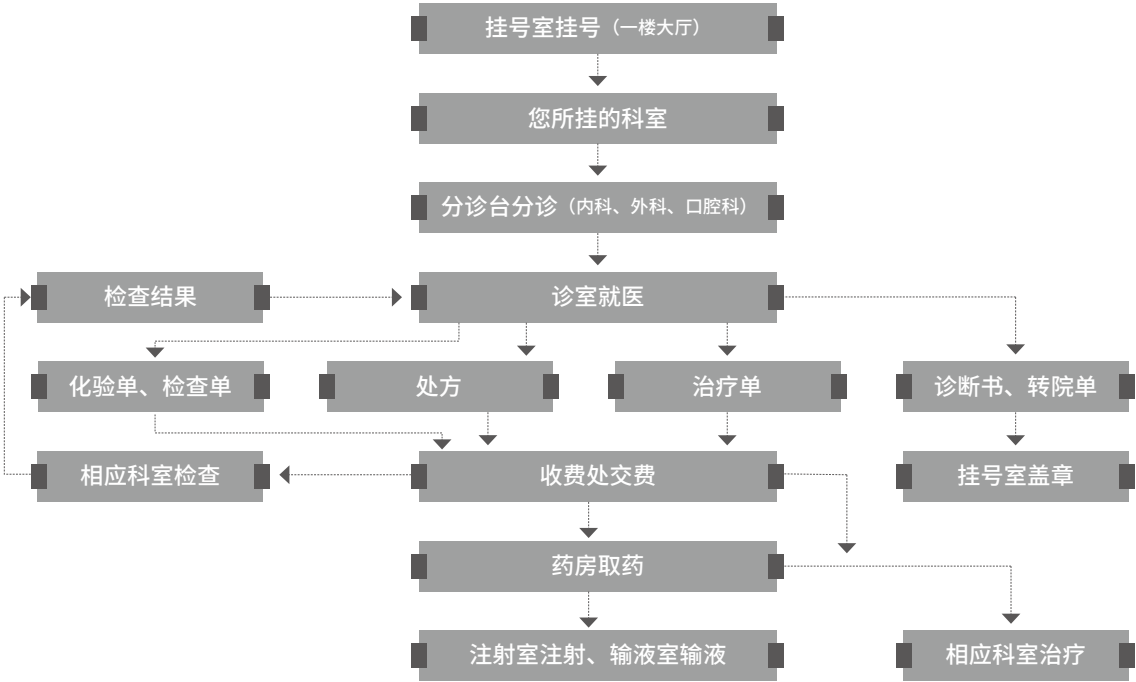
